

Descendants of Charles Bryan

Generation No. 1

1. CHARLES¹ BRYAN¹ was born Unknown, and died Unknown. He married ELIZABETH STANGER¹ 19 Oct 1813 in Whitby¹, daughter of WILLIAM STANGER and HANNAH FISHWICK. She was born 16 Jan 1794¹, and died Unknown.

Notes for CHARLES BRYAN:

1841 Census No record found to date, - Feb 2005

However his youngest son Timothy Castley Bryan was born in Hartlepool around 1840, so the family were probably in Hartlepool for the 1841 census. Timothy does however appear in Whitby in the 1851 cesus - aged 10 living in the household of his brother Charles and wife Hannah - see notes for Timothy.

To date (March 2005), no birth records have been found for Charles, although the following pieces of information may provide some clues:

Data from IGI

(A) Thomas Bryan married Mary Gage on 19/8/1771 in Skelton by Guisboro - M109602 0919077

Children from Thomas Bryan & Mary:

(B) Thomas Bryan christened 28/8/1781

(C) Charles Bryan born 9/6/1791, christened 28/12/1812

(D) Timothy Castley married Mary Bryan on 24/2/1767 in Skelton by Guisboro

(E) Thomas Castley married Mary Scarth on 29/3/1744 in Skelton by Guisboro

One might suppose the following:

(E) was the marriage which produced Timothy in (D)

Mary Bryan in (D) & Thomas Bryan in (A) were siblings

Charles in (C) could be the same Charles who married Elizabeth Stanger as two of the surnames of above marriages were used as christian names for children of Charles & Elizabeth! This Charles would have been 22 at the time of his marriage.

1851 Census living at Ripley's Buildings - aged 26, Labourer with wife Jane - aged 37 and a visitor Jane Bonnard - aged 18 Ref. HO107/2374 Folio327b sched 142

1861 Census living at Millers Yard - aged 35, Mason with wife Jane - aged 47

1871 Census living at 11 Dark Entry Yard - aged 48, Stonemason - widower
1881 Census living at Dark Entry Yard - aged 54, Stonemason, with wife Isabella - aged 40 and son William T Bryan - aged 8 scholar
1891 Census living at dark Entry Yard - aged 67, Stone Dresser, with wife Isabella - aged 48 and son Wm T - aged 18 - Apprentice at Sea
1901 Census living at Dark Entry Yard - aged 78, Stonemason, living with wife Isabella - aged 56

Marriage Notes for WILLIAM BRYAN and JANE MILLER:
Fathers were: Charles Bryan - Stonemason & William Miller - Gardener
Witnesses to the marriage were: Thomas Readhaed & Ralph Greenbury

- v. HANNAH BRYAN³, b. 30 Aug 1825, Whitby, Yorkshire³; d. Sep 1867, Whitby, Yorkshire Ref Whitby 9d 295; m. DAVID WILSON, Whitby; b. Scotland?.

Notes for HANNAH BRYAN:

1841 Census Living in Ruswarp, Whitby, aged 15 at New Buildings in household of Elizabeth Benson, aged 60 - probably employed as a domestic
1851 Census - unable to locate in Wigan - may have gone to Scotland with new baby Elizabeth
1861 Census - living in Baxtergate, Whitby, aged 35 with daughters Elizabeth Wilson, aged 10 & Emily Dawson Wilson aged 3

Died September 1867 - Cause of death thought to be cancer - ref Christine

- vi. FRANCES BRYAN³, b. 11 Jan 1828, Whitby, Yorkshire³; d. Unknown; m. RICHARD RAYNE³; b. 1825³; d. Unknown.

Notes for FRANCES BRYAN:

1861 Census living in Baxtergate - aged 33- with husband Richard Rayne - aged 35, Seaman - and Timothy Bryan, her brother - aged 19

More About RICHARD RAYNE:

Occupation: Mariner³

- vii. CHARLES BRYAN³, b. 29 Mar 1831, Whitby, Yorkshire³; d. 04 Jan 1897, Whitby³; m. HANNAH JEFFERSON³; b. 1831, Whitby, Yorkshire³; d. 11 Jan 1905, Leeds³.

Notes for CHARLES BRYAN:

1851 Census living in Baxtergate - aged 20 - Jet Turner, empl 10 apprentices, with wife Hannah - aged 20, sisters Fanny - aged 22, employed as servant, Elizabeth -aged 14, at school , brother Timothy - aged 10, at school

1861 Census living in Baxtergate - aged 30 - Jet Ornament Manufacturer, with wife Hannah - aged 30, daughters Jane - aged 7, scholar, Lucy - aged 5, Mary H - aged 1 and son George P - aged 1 month. Also in the household were Fanny W Basgette -aged 30, Shopwoman and Margaret Unwin - aged 64, Midwife.

1871 Census living at 5 Well Close Square - aged 40 - Jet Ornament Manufacturer, with wife Ann, dau Jennie E - aged 18, son Henry G - aged 8, dau Eliza a - aged 6, sons Arthur N - aged 5 and Timothy C - aged 2 & dau Eugenie aged 6 months

1881 Census living at 5 Well Close Square - aged 49 - Jet Ornament Manufacturer, employing 23 men, 4 women & 3 boys - with wife Hannah - aged 48, son Harry - aged 18 - asst Jet Worker, dau Eliza A - aged 16 - , son Arthur N - aged 13 - scholar, dau Eugene - aged 10 - scholar & Thomas - aged 6 - scholar.

1891 Census living at 5 Well Close Square - aged 59 - Jet Ornament Manufacturer, with wife Hannah - aged 58 and sons Hy Geo P - aged 29 - Jet Worker & Thomas J - aged 18 - Jet Worker and grandson Alfred Chas - aged 3

Notes for THOMAS BRYAN:

1861 Census, living in Princess Place - aged 29 - Jet Worker, with wife Margaret - aged 33 and son Richard Henry - aged 4 months
1871 Census, living at 76 Baxtergate -aged 39- Ornament manufacturer, with wife Margaret - aged 44 - and daughter Margaret H - aged 3

1881 Census, living at 6 Spring Hill Terrace, Ruswarp -aged 47, with wife Margaret - aged 54 and daughters Elizabeth M -aged 18, Margaret H - aged 13 and son Thomas - aged 15

(There seems to be an age discrepancy here -maybe it a handwriting problem and should be 49)

The sign for the shop high up on the wall at 76 Baxtergate was still visible on our last visit to Whitby in the late 1990's - I have a photo of it

Notes for TIMOTHY CASTLEY BRYAN:

1851 Census living in Baxtergate - aged 10 with his brother Charles - aged 20, Charles' wife Hannah - aged 20 and sisters Fanny - aged 22 - employed as a servant- and Elizabeth - aged 14
1861 Census living in Baxtergate, aged 19, with Richard Rayne, his wife Frances (his sister)
1881 Census living in Nottingham at Addison Villas, Radcliffe On Trent - aged 39 with wife Ellen - aged 38, born in Nottingham. (Head of household is his mother-in-law Sarah Hopkin - widow - aged 69 - born in Liverpool, her gdaughter Lucy A Whysall - aged 12 - born in Ripley Derbyshire and Susan Dodsworth - aged 18 - born in Grantham Lincolnshire - Servant

Death record found on FreeBMD (Feb 2005) - died 9th February 1908 - aged 68 ref Nantwich Vol 8a P 234.

Cemetry record (8th feb 2005) Buried 12th february 1908 in grave no 1156A. The assistant remarked that this was probably an unpurchased grave at the time as the following people were buried in it:

4th June 1883 Eliza Speight aged 12

17th September 1895 Florence Penny aged 6 wks

then Timothy Bryan

25th November 1969 Simon John Lucas aged 18 hours

21st February 1982 Christopher Johnson aged 7 days The grave was purchased by this childs father.

The age at death and the ages at the census returns would question the originally specified birth date of 26th October 1842. A check on the IGI revealed that this date was a christening date, not a birth date.(8th Feb 2005)
