

# *Descendants of Hannah Bryan*

## *Generation No. 1*

1. HANNAH<sup>4</sup> BRYAN (*CHARLES<sup>3</sup>, THOMAS<sup>2</sup>, THOMAS<sup>1</sup>*)<sup>1</sup> was born 31 Aug 1825 in Whitby, Yorkshire<sup>1</sup>, and died 22 Sep 1867 in Whitby, Yorkshire Ref Whitby 9d 295. She married DAVID WILSON Sep 1846 in Whitby, Yorkshire ref Whitby 24 551, son of JOHN SCOTLAND. He was born 1820 in Scotland.

1841 Census Living in Hartlepool aged 15 with parents Charles & Elizabeth and their family

1851 Census - living in Oldham aged 25 with husband David and daughters Mary aged 3 and Elizabeth 2 months - found in the 1851 Unfilmed census

1861 Census - living in Baxtergate, Whitby, aged 35 with daughters Elizabeth Wilson, aged 10 & Emily Dawson Wilson aged 3

Died 22nd September 1867 - Cause of death thought to be cancer - ref Christine. Death certificate shows cause of death as Metritis - inflammation of the womb. Samuel Anderson, a lawyer, of Fishburn Road, Ruswarp was the informer present at the death.

He was born 1849 in Barnard Castle, Durham ref Teesdale vol24 p424, and died Jun 1875 in Darlington, Durham ref vol 10a p 19. She married (2) JAMES VICKERS BULMER Sep 1876 in Darlington, Durham ref vol 10a p 8. He was born 1839 in Darlington, Durham, and died Jun 1884 in Darlington, Durham ref vol 10a p 2. She married (3) JOHN HALLAND 1888. He was born 1835 in Newcastle, Northumberland.

ELIZABETH<sup>5</sup> WILSON (*HANNAH<sup>4</sup> BRYAN, CHARLES<sup>3</sup>, THOMAS<sup>2</sup>, THOMAS<sup>1</sup>*) was born 29 Jan 1851 in Chapel Street, Queen Street, Wigan, and died 25 Jul 1941 in Whitby, Yorkshire 9d 749. She married MARTIN ROE 11 Jan 1869 in St Hilda's Catholic Church, Whitby, Yorkshire 9d 183, son of WILLIAM ROE and JANE WRAY. He was born 18 Jan 1852 in Baxtergate, Whitby, Yorkshire, and died 16 Feb 1929 in 17 Windsor Terrace, Whitby, Yorkshire 9d 821.

Notes for ELIZABETH WILSON:

Time of birth 3am - suggests a multiple birth

A mystery always surrounded why Elizabeth who was born in Wigan, Lancashire would meet Martin, who always stayed in Whitby. This was solved when the 1861 census info was found (see below) The family story is that David Wilson, the father, left Hannah and went to Scotland.

Hannah had returned to her roots in Whitby, close to the Bryan and Stanger families (her immediate ancestors) and this is the reason why Emily was born in Whitby. It is not yet established whether David had left Hannah before or after the birth of Emily or indeed if he ever came to Whitby.

When I obtained Emily's birth certificate in 2007, it was clear that David had left Hannah long before Emily was conceived, No father was named on the birth certificate and Emily was named as Emily Dawson suggesting the father was possibly a Dawson from Whitby area!

Emily's marriage certificate shows her father to be David Wilson (deceased), but I doubt this to be the case on the above evidence!

1861 Census aged 10, living in Baxtergate, Whitby with mother Hannah Wilson, aged 35 and sister Emily Dawson Wilson aged 3

After Hannah's death (between 1861 & 1871), Emily went to live with Robert & Mary Wilson (nee Stanger), who was her great Aunt.

Notes for FRANCIS ROE:

According to Auntie Peggie, Aunt Fanny took her father - Francis Roe - to be baptised just after birth, because attention was being lavished on his twin brother John William, who subsequently died 10 days after birth. This was the reason why he was named Francis.

Occupation in Whitby until sometime in 1901 was a Ship's Draughtsman, then moved to Belfast to work for Workman & Clarke on Admiralty work. A brief return to England in 1910 to Hull in the shipyards. Finally came back to England permanently in 1925 to work at Cammell Lairds in Birkenhead.
